

TAF REQUEST FORM

TAF requests are submitted to the EuroMed Justice (EMJ) Project Team by at least two SPCs or by one SPC and one EU MS. The activities requested must support initiatives related to specific cross-border situations, that are not explicitly planned, and activities aimed at strengthening SPCs capacities and capabilities in specific areas, while contributing to the achievement of the overall [EMJ objective and purposes](#).¹

TAF activities can be of 6 different types:

1. Operational meetings between at least two SPCs, for example to discuss one or several ongoing cases;
2. Operational meetings between at least one SPC and one EU, for example to discuss one or several ongoing cases;
3. Operational meetings on specific criminal phenomena affecting the EU and/or the Southern Neighbourhood or parts thereof, for example to discuss a group of cases revealing a criminal phenomenon;
4. Preliminary meetings to assess the suitability of cases for Eurojust support, for example if a case already concerns EU MS and also concerns one or several SPC(s), facilitate the organisation of a preliminary meeting with the relevant representatives to assess if the Eurojust case could also be opened to the SPC(s) concerned;
5. Financing through the TAF increased participation of representatives from a SPC in Eurojust cases and in cases related coordination meetings or coordination centres (for instance to support, with the agreement of the EU MS involved in the case, increased participation from SPCs, in term of number of participants or of nights of accommodation);
6. Support the strengthening of capacities and capabilities of the SPCs, for example by organising an activity focused on a specific crime phenomenon that could include the study of practical cases.
